Theerakit Kian Lee, or Thee, is the eldest son of the Lee family, an old mafia lineage. Leaving his past in arms trafficking behind, Thee moves to Thailand to launch a perfume and accessory brand called “Archaynie.” For his latest perfume collection, he hires Peach (Peachayarat Janekit), a well-known photographer, while Aran, a model close to Peach, is chosen as the face of the campaign. As an introvert, Peach enjoys his simple, quiet life, but that peace is shattered after he meets Thee at a party.

When Peach steps in to protect Aran from harassment, he unexpectedly confronts the intimidating ex-mafia, Thee, who bluntly declares his desire for a one-night stand with Aran. Peach advises him that if he wants Aran, he should start by approaching him respectfully and making a good impression. However, Thee's behavior around Aran quickly becomes exaggerated, leaving Peach shocked by what he witnesses. Thee wields his influence to pressure Peach into helping him pursue Aran.

Peach later learns from his sister, Plup, that Thee is the owner of the company they work for. With Thee's reputation as an intimidating ex-mafia figure, Peach feels he has no choice but to agree to help him. There, he meets Yu (Ohm Thitiwat), a strikingly handsome man with an impressive background, and the two share an instant spark. Upon returning to Bangkok and spending a few intense weeks together, North decides to marry Yu, disregarding the warnings of his cautious cousin, Pai (Mark Jiruntanin). Concerned that North might be falling into a trap, Pai confides in his fiancé, Tim (Junior Panachai), but his efforts to convince North to call off the wedding ultimately fail.

The truth is, no one suspects that Yu isn't who he claims to be. Worse still, Pai is unaware that it's not just Yu who's a scammer; his own fiancé, Tim, is also part of the same con artist ring. Before long, Pai's secretary, Nana, uncovers Yu's deceit. Shocked, Pai orders North to divorce Yu immediately. However, there's a catch. 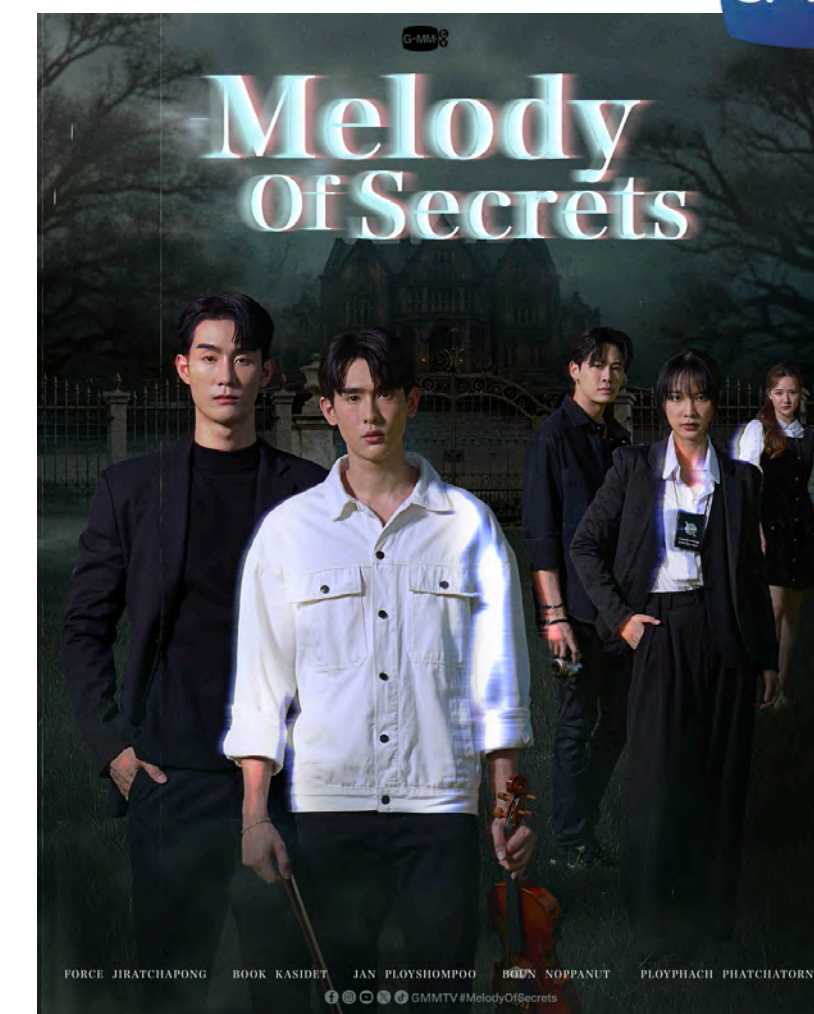

One day, Rati sneaks away to visit a temple festival alone, where he encounters Theerathorn, a man who helps him catch a pickpocket. 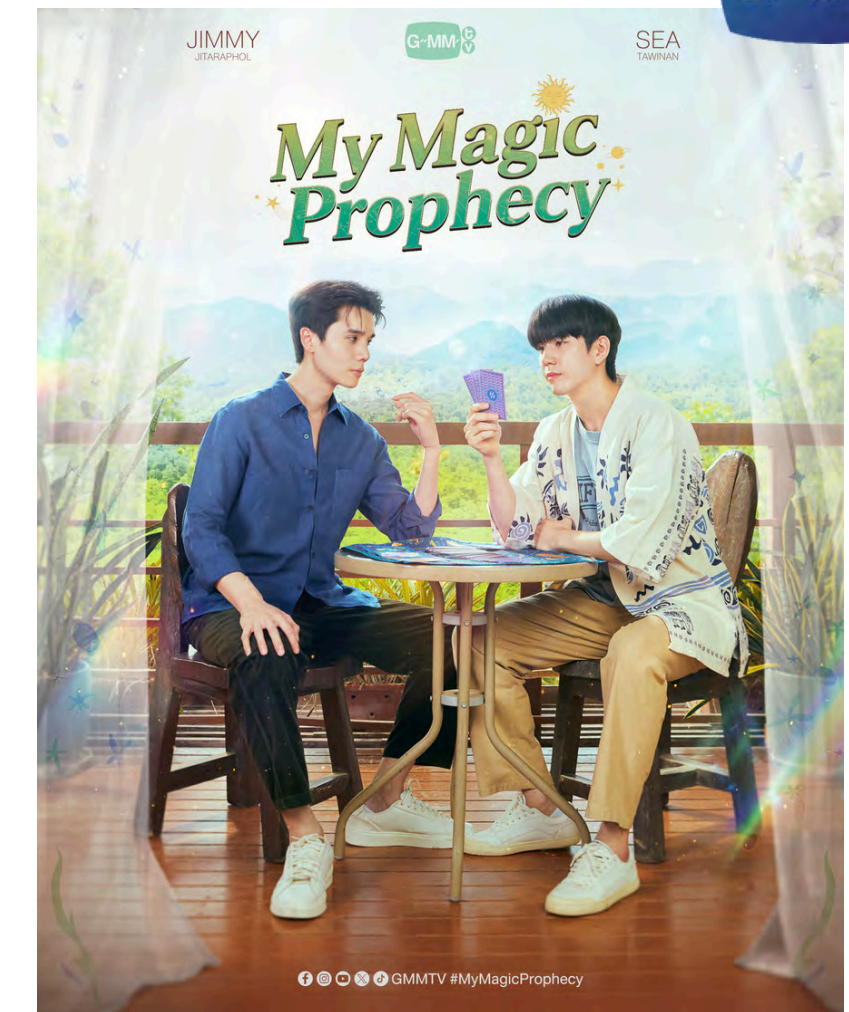

Instead of simply dining and entertaining the client, he disrupts the meeting by asking interview-style questions until the client storms out in frustration, leaving without paying. This entire scene is quietly observed by Kor.

Kor Koravic is a businessman and the owner of Hive, a famous online retail platform with billion-dollar revenue within just a year, despite having no central office or in-house designers. Instead, the company relies on runway fashion knockoffs and AI-assisted designs. While awaiting the completion of his new home, Kor temporarily resides in a luxury hotel penthouse. Known for his reclusive nature and aversion to socializing, Kor even operates Hive under a nominee's name. With this aversion to visibility, he's been searching for someone to act as his representative in business dealings—until he notices Jira's defiant attitude and bold handling of his client at the restaurant, sparking his interest.

Kor decides to send a message to Jira via the waiter, offering a substantial sum to hire him and inviting him to discuss the details back at his hotel. Jira, assuming that he is hired for personal services, ends up in Kor's suite, only to realize that the "job" is simply to portray "Mr. K" in business negotiations. Surprised but not overly concerned after seeing the payment, he agrees.

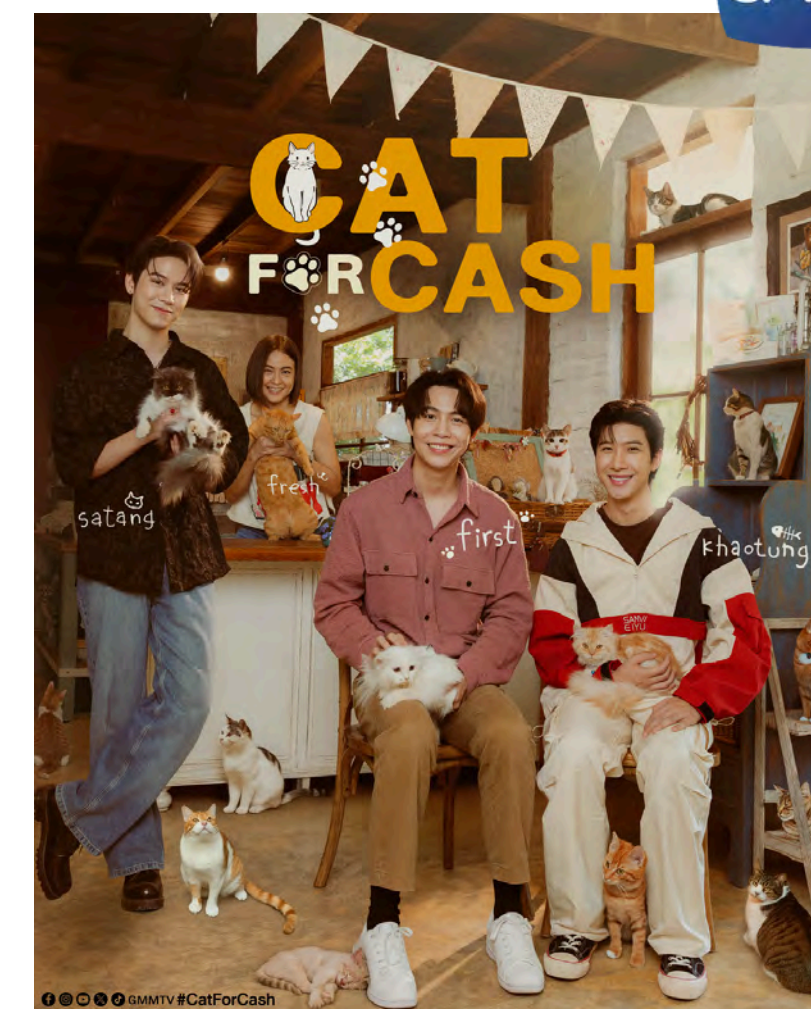

When the police inspector Kamin Kananon tries to break up a brawl, he meets his new colleague at his new precinct, the hot-headed police captain Jade Jaruwat. Now the two must work together to bust some drug cartel by going undercover at a nightclub. This is where Kamin meets Jay, Jade's younger brother, who is out drinking with his friends.

Jay and his seven friends, Time, Tonkla, Puifai, Cherene, Belle, Champ, and Tar, are senior year engineering students. The group of eight shows up at their faculty's hazing, and seeing they should let loose before midterm week starts, sneaks into an empty storage room for a little party.

The senior students talk about the coming exams and life after college, before playing a game of Truth or Dare where players can either choose to tell the truth or alternatively accept a dare. The game goes on as drinks after drinks are knocked back. Everyone's consciousness is fading as the night progresses. With his last shred of wakefulness, Jay calls his big brother to tell him he won't be coming home tonight, and passes out drunk like the rest.

Morning arrives, and as everyone's waking up, they find that the eight lives partying together last night have come down to seven because Puifai has become a lifeless body. In a panic, Jay offers to call his cop brother for help, only for his friends to stop him. They call an ambulance instead, but help arrives too late because Puifai is already dead.

Certain there has been death, Jay calls his brother. The investigation begins as it should, with Jade and Kamin talking to each student about what happened. The first suspicion comes when the two cops hear uncoordinated answers from different people. When the medical examiner, Puth, takes a look at the body, he announces that the victim has died of murder, seeing there are several harmful substances in Puifai's body. Learning that the group of eight has had their problems before, Kamin determines there could be foul play at work behind this death.

But before they could even conclude the case, death has claimed another life in this friend group. One of the boys, Tar, has received an anonymous letter with his name on it, presenting him with two options like in a Truth or Dare game they played that fateful night. Thinking it is some sort of prank, Tar dismisses it and goes about his life like usual by going out clubbing. He gets murdered by someone in a face mask, making him the second victim in this case.

Kamin and Jade must now work harder than before to solve this case. But as Kamin has just been transferred to his new job, he still struggles with finding a place to stay. Jade, thinking it'd help make their job easier, offers his own place as a temporary fix. While the two cops are looking for the letter addressed to Tar, the rest of the friend group is getting suspicious of each other with every breath, knowing a letter is coming for them, too.

The next letter comes for Tonkla, exposing him of the crimes he's done in the past. But there is one difference in this letter: the dare option in the game is gone. Instead of being the next victim, however, he's narrowly escaped death by making Belle pay for it. Belle also receives a letter, and as panic seizes her after seeing her own crimes being exposed in the letter, she accepts the dare without hesitation. Belle chooses to let someone in the group die in her place, not knowing Tonkla has chosen the same, and he chooses her. And so another life is claimed.

Pressure is growing heavier for the detectives, from themselves, the future victims, and the higher-ups. Kamin and Jade must dig faster for more information and try to find the murderer who's still out there. When the two receive news about Cherene from Belle, they show up at her place to find that Belle is now dead. Jay's and Cherene's names are in Belle's letter. But with everyone hiding their secrets from the two detectives, investigation is proven slow. One such secret is the fact that, on the night Puifai died, Cherene and Puifai were pulling a mean practical prank on the rest of their friends.

Now the forensic team, Kamin, and Jade work together to find more clues. They learn that the acid used to kill Belle comes from a notorious nightclub The Wild Hunt, a nightclub owned by some South Korean businessman operating an illegal crime syndicate in Thailand and buying off the police. Kamin himself has been offered a bribe, and working with a special task force to bring down this syndicate, he agrees to take it for the sake of the investigation.

The two detectives go to the nightclub to find more evidence. And while things are going down, the murderer strikes again. This time, Tonkla is the victim, while Jay witnesses the murder and gets attacked as a result.

With more dead bodies, the repertoire of suspects gets smaller. Trust becomes scarce when the person who attacks Jay is none other than his own best friend, Time, who receives a letter earlier and chooses to hurt his friend on a dare to save his own life. But whether he chooses to tell the truth or accept a dare, it only ends in death.

Jade and Kamin trace the footsteps in the letters and decide to investigate different places. They learn that the friendship between all eight friends is nothing but a hoax, full of lies, deceptions, and betrayals. The more they find out, the closer they are to the murderer.

Meanwhile, Cherene and Champs are getting suspicious of each other. The two friends receive their own letters, and Jay, who is still recovering in the hospital, does as well.

Fearing for her life, Cherene confides in Champ about the prank she and Puifai came up with that night, confessing that they had help from a doctor like Puth. She then goes on to insist that Puifai's death wasn't part of the plan. Champ, who records the whole conversation, chooses to betray her trust and send the voice record to Jade and Kamin. With that lead, Puth is put on the map in this case.

Being a big-name politician's only son, Champ's father threatens Kamin his career if they don't erase Champ's name off the case. Kamin refuses for his ideal, and gets himself suspended at work for unspecified time. Jade now has to work alone.

When his badge no longer works, Kamin chooses to make himself useful at the hospital instead. He shows up to find that Jay is gone, and after asking around, learns that Jay has left on his own free will. Meanwhile, Jade finally pieces together the connection between Puth and Puifai who seem to be involved romantically. He also learns that Puth is always present whenever there's been a death. And most importantly, Puifai's body has disappeared from the morgue.

At the same time, Jay walks into a house in the suburb. He finds the deaths of his friends playing out on a television in the basement of the house, with the person responsible for it all in the same room with him. Puth starts explaining about this fake friend group and Puifai. Feeling anxious, Jay keeps his guard up, but then Puth points a gun at him, making him choose the options in the letter: the death of either Cherene or Champ. When Jay refuses to choose any, someone unexpected shows up: Puifai.

Kamin arrives at the house and sneaks in quietly to find Jay badly hurt in the basement and the videos still playing on the television. Jay recounts to him what Fai has told him before getting shot.

At the same time, the upper floor of the house has been turned into a gladiator arena. But instead of lions, it's Cherene and Champ inside a cage being pitched against each other by Puifai. When the two friends see someone who should have been dead staring at them with malice in her eyes, they are speechless. With patience and calm, Puifai tells them about her grudge, resentment, and hatred that she's accumulated over the years, before telling them about the plan she stakes her life on to get revenge.

Fights between Kamin and Fai, Jade and Puth, and Chame and Cherene break out in the house. 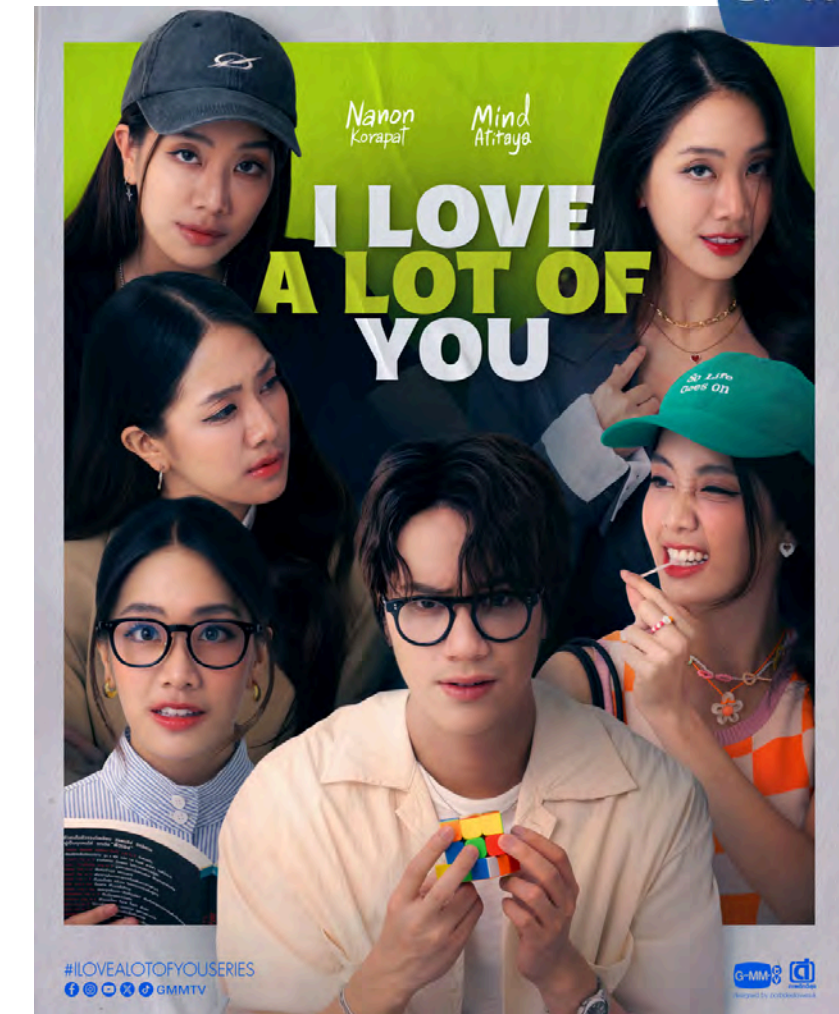

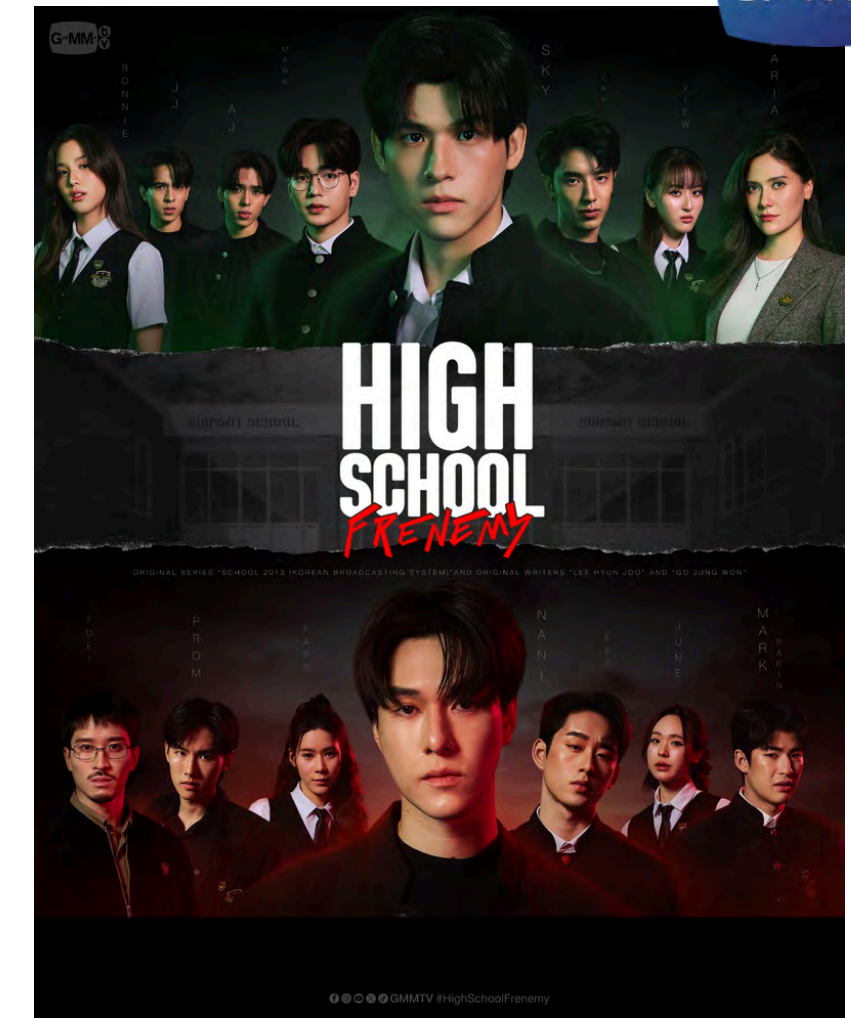

In response to many fans' requests, he uploads a photo of 'Ark' (Force Jiratchapong), a third-year Civil Engineering student, unaware of the prohibition against doing so, as Ark vehemently objects to such actions. Not knowing the admin's identity, Ark sends a harsh message demanding the photo be deleted. Arm immediately detests Ark's rudeness and develops a dislike for the man. Despite his reservations, Arm finds himself occasionally interacting with Ark, not only because of their mentorship but also because many people seek Arm's assistance to connect with the blunt and private Ark.

What Arm does not know is that he is in Ark's inner circle because Ark wants him to. Ark, smitten with Arm at first sight, secretly cares for him and endeavors to better himself to become a suitable match for Arm. Despite his typically hot-headed nature and penchant for risk-taking, Ark restrains himself out of fear of endangering Arm. Meanwhile, Arm remains oblivious to Ark's feelings. Amidst the chaos and many headaches, Arm gradually begins to understand his own heart. Before they realize it, their relationship evolves from peer mentor and peer mentee to boyfriends.

On the first day of university life, disaster strikes hard for Gun (Chimon Wachirawit). As hapless as he is, Gun accidentally breaks a bathroom faucet and finds himself soaked like a puppy. With a stroke of luck, one classmate comes to his rescue. However, amidst the chaos, Gun is too preoccupied to get a good look at the person's face, only catching a glimpse of their shoes. As he tries to navigate his new surroundings and classmates, Gun is determined to find the one who saved him from the bathroom mishap. Eventually, he tracks down Faifa (Junior Panachai) and expresses his gratitude, unaware that Faifa knows nothing of the incident. This becomes problematic when he shares an on-campus dorm with a roommate who can't tolerate sleeping with the lights on. Yotha, however, has no such issue and offers to switch places with Gun's roommate, as he rarely returns to the dorm at night. Yotha keeps his promise, disappearing after dark and returning in the morning. Gun is suspicious of Yotha's nocturnal activities; rumors swirl, suggesting he's mingling with girls or involved in illicit activities. Gun attempts to confront Yotha about it, but Yotha always avoids the subject.

Yotha is fearful of love, disappointment, and loss. He does not want to lose his mother, as he did with his father. He does not want to be abandoned as his ex-lover did to him. 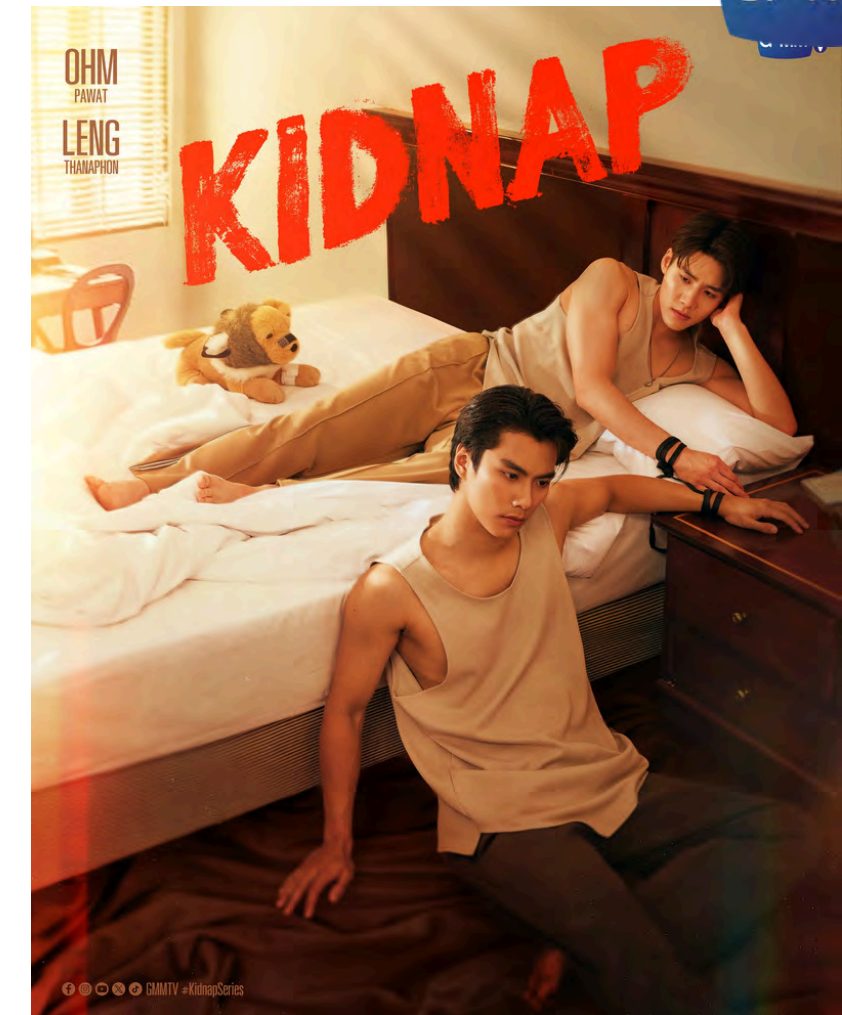

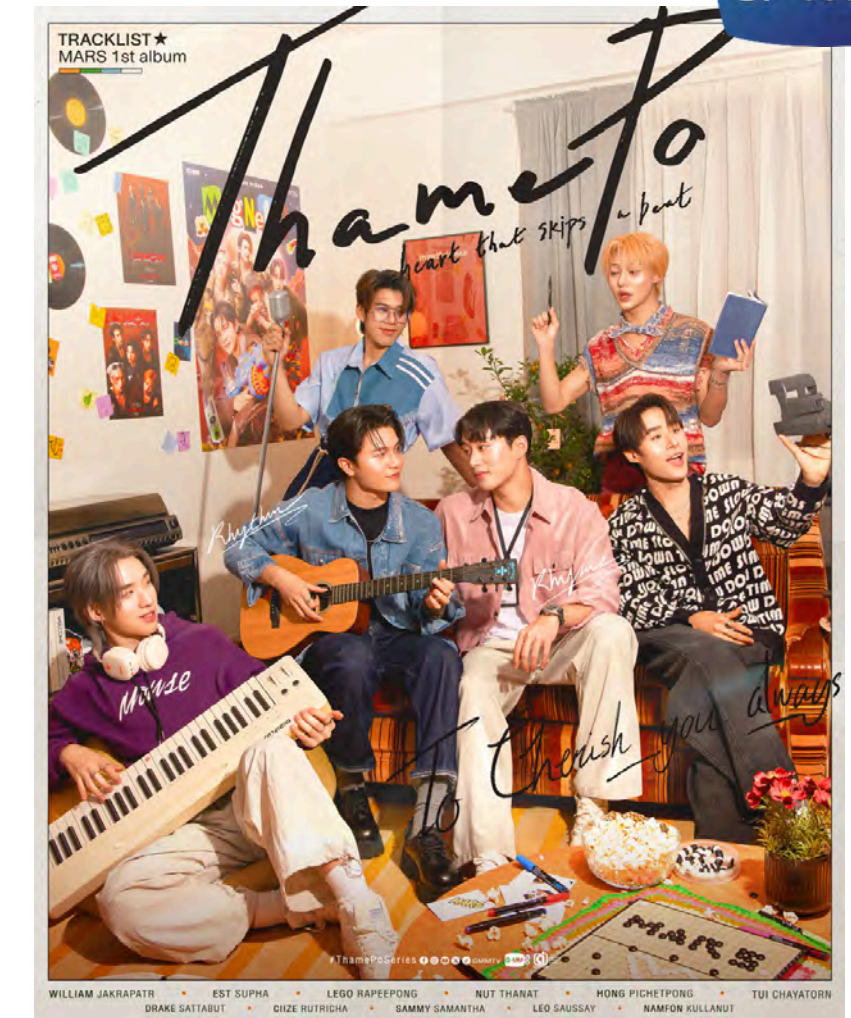

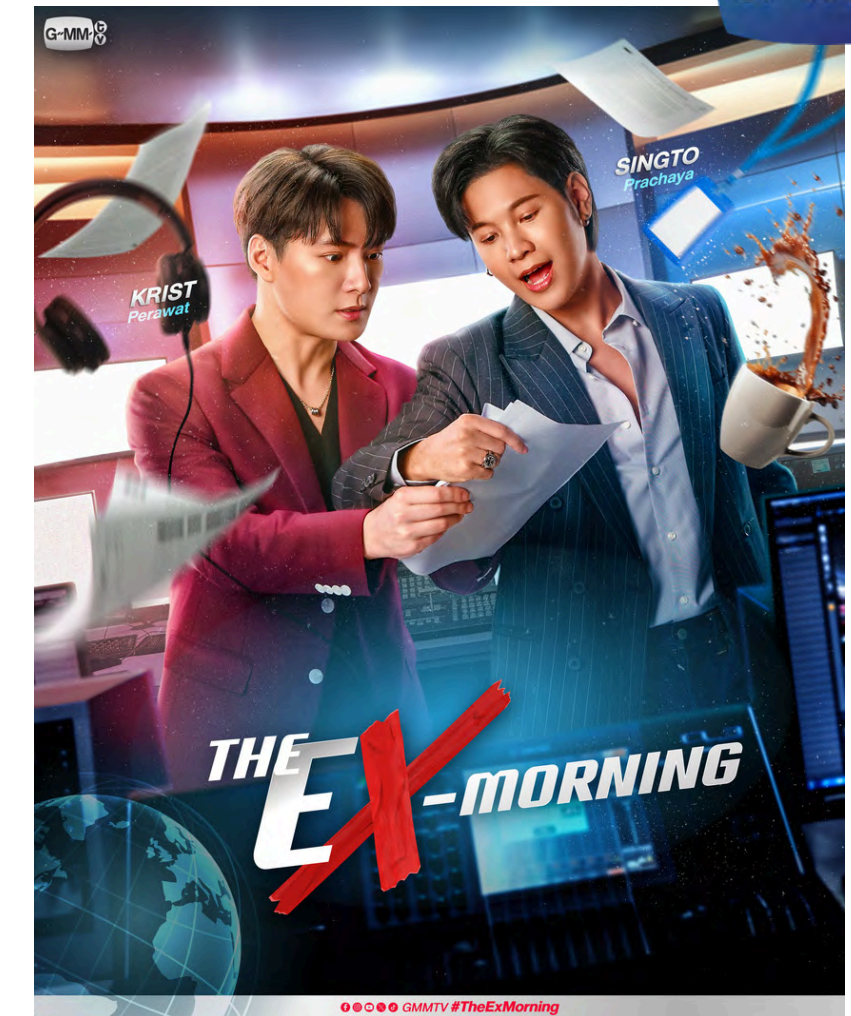

Chao Saen Thep decides to keep quiet instead of fighting for the one he loves. Nabun slips out of death when someone decides to give themselves in. Chao Mueang Fah takes Nabun to a house on the mountain to escape the chaos. Nabun gets closer to Chao Mueang Fah and realizes that behind his stern exterior is love and unconditional care.
